Motion was made by Thomas Gaulrapp and seconded by Ramon Accettella, Jr. to accept the minutes from the Public Hearing on Tuesday, September 11, 2018 for Lakeville Industries, Inc. (d/b/a Lakeville Kitchen & Bath). Mr. Dolan stated that no one from the public was present nor were there any written comments submitted. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion was made by Ramon Accettella, Jr. and seconded by Marcus Duffin, to adopt a Resolution granting approval of and authorizing the grant of certain financial assistance by the Town of Babylon Industrial Development Agency to Lakeville Industries, Inc. (d/b/a Lakeville Kitchen & Bath) and Lakeville Realty Co. in connection with the acquisition, renovation and equipping of an office and showroom facility and warehousing and distribution facility to be located at 140 Broadhollow Road, Farmingdale, New York and 45 Cabot Street in West Babylon, New York; and permitting for purposes of providing the terms and conditions for which the Company will receive the benefit of certain New York State Sales and Use Tax exemptions in connection with the Project, the execution and delivery of the Interim Documents (preliminary sales tax agreements and/or documents).
