Our company E.clips USA, was established almost 13 years ago in its present location. The competitive nature of our industry (Selling to discount stores) and more importantly, because of some significant advantages that our competition enjoys over it is necessary at this point that we make a move.

Our main competition is a company New Jersey. They enjoy lower rents and lower taxes for their operation. The high cost of leasing on Long island and the inevitable raises in rent demanded by landlords will take any degree of competitiveness away from us. Even a company in Los Angeles has made some headway in our market because they enjoy much lower rents and taxes. In order to continue a successful and viable business, our company needs the security of owning its home (as opposed to leasing) with controlled costs which will remain not only predictable and in par with competition, but also reasonable for the foreseeable future.

At the present, our work force consists of 3 of us in the office, 4 people in warehousing and delivery, and 5 sales representatives who act as independent contractors.

In the past 3 years, as the owner of E.Clips USA which is a sub chapter S corporation, my total renumeration has been about \$140,000 per year. Out of that, \$36,000 is listed under wages and the balance is received under the S corporation distribution of profits.

2 Office employees with clerical duties receive an average salary of about \$25,000 per year.

4 warehouse workers and driver (One is a new employee. Please see below) receive an average salary of \$23,500 per year.

The sales representatives who were responsible for about 95% of about 2.5 million dollars of sales for the company receive a commission towards their sales which averages about 5%.

In anticipation of this move and with an eye towards necessary growth that the new place will allow us to pursue, we have hired one warehouse person already (not reflected in the submitted W-2) at a salary of \$350.00per week.

Additionally, after considering a number of people, another employee will start on October 18, 2011. She will be in charge of securing new customers and following up with our sales representatives to make sure our present customers' needs are met. Additionally, she will have the duty of researching and recognizing new products to add to our line in order to make our company more attractive to customers. In short she will be concentrating on the company's growth. We count on her to make a significant positive difference in our sales. Her salary annual salary will be \$46,500.

It is of note that the 2 new employees have been hired strictly in anticipation of moving to 10 Ranick Dr. in Amityville.

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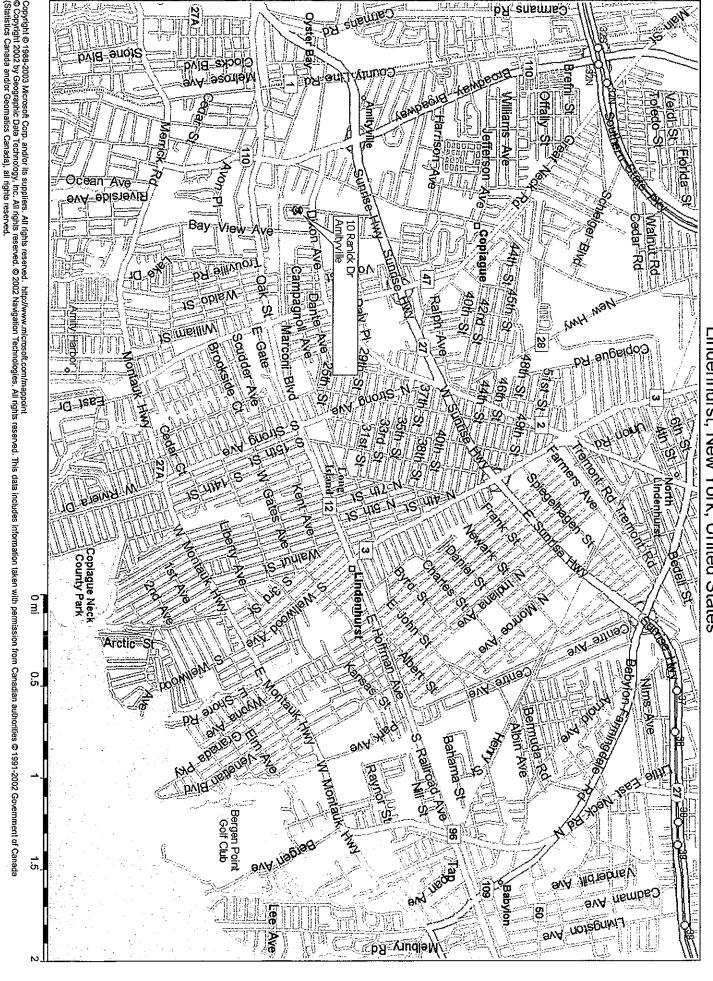
